Lilies for Bedding. Forwarded immediately care beyond that of general supply of coarse material about the plant should be taken. sun may injure them. A water should not come in contact about six inches deep. Out easily grown.

Pot Culture.—Put them in 5 or 6 loamy soil, one-fourth well-rotted manure also some broken pieces of peat. Place the bulb in the center.
