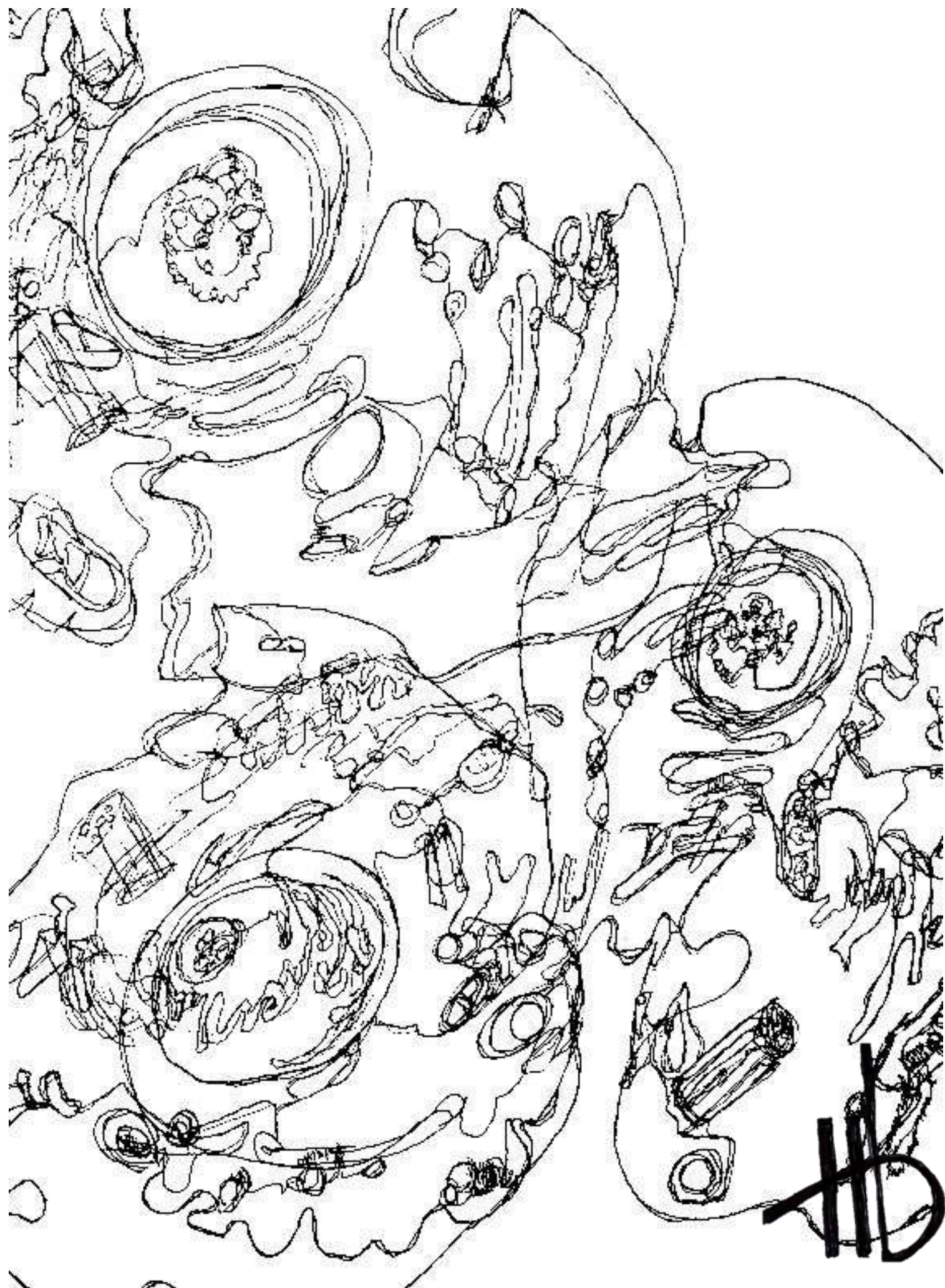


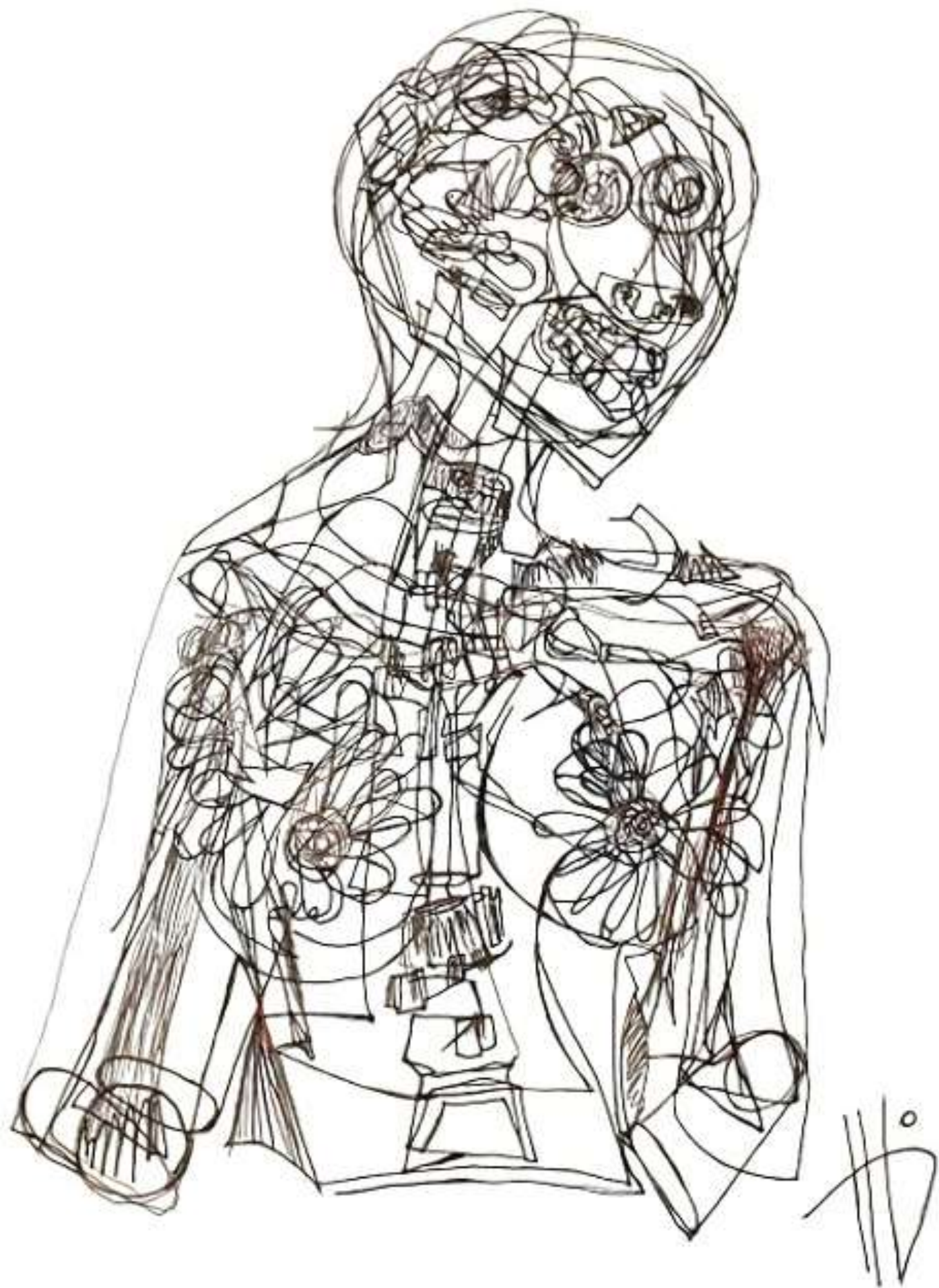
This art technique of blind contour starts when I shut my eyes and use a single continuous line of black ink, not lifting or peeking, and using my imagination to create a new image. After the organic shapes are revealed, I open my eyes and fill in with color using alcohol markers, colored pencils, watercolors or acrylic paint.

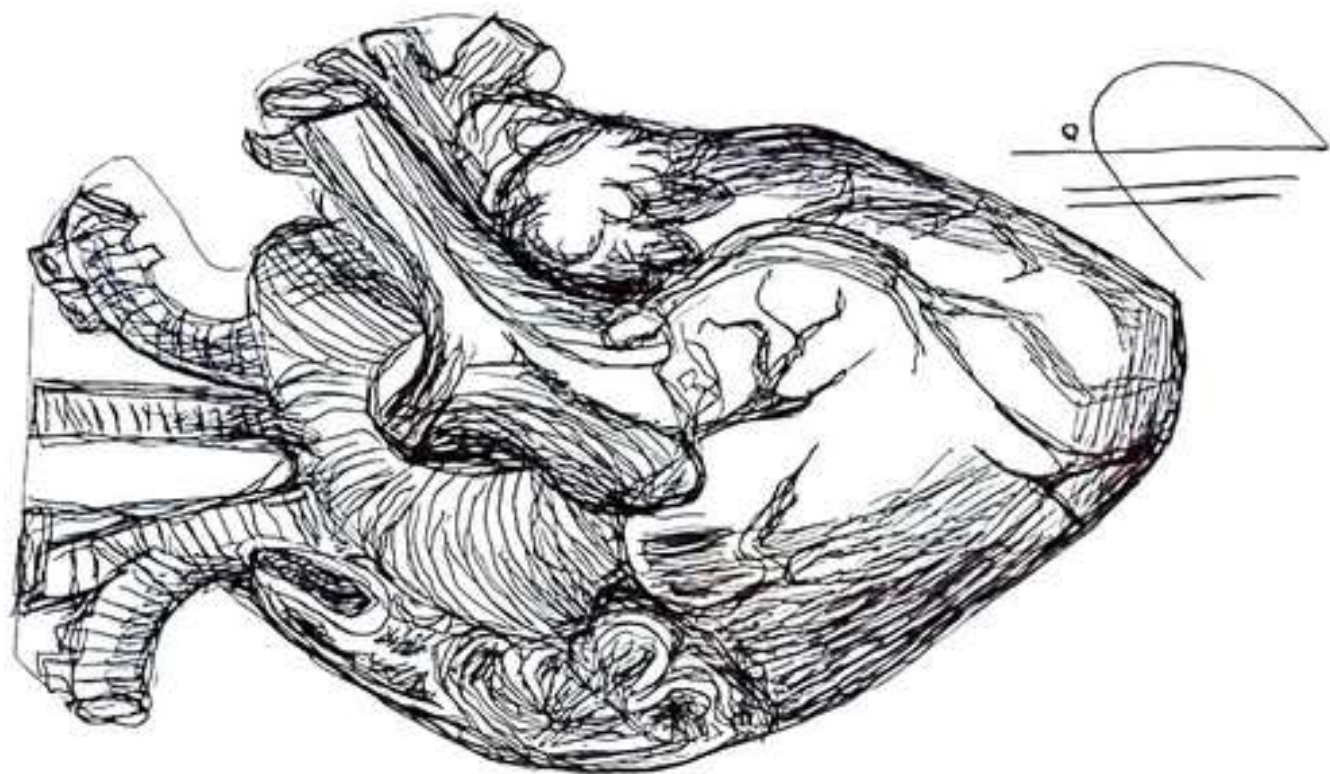
